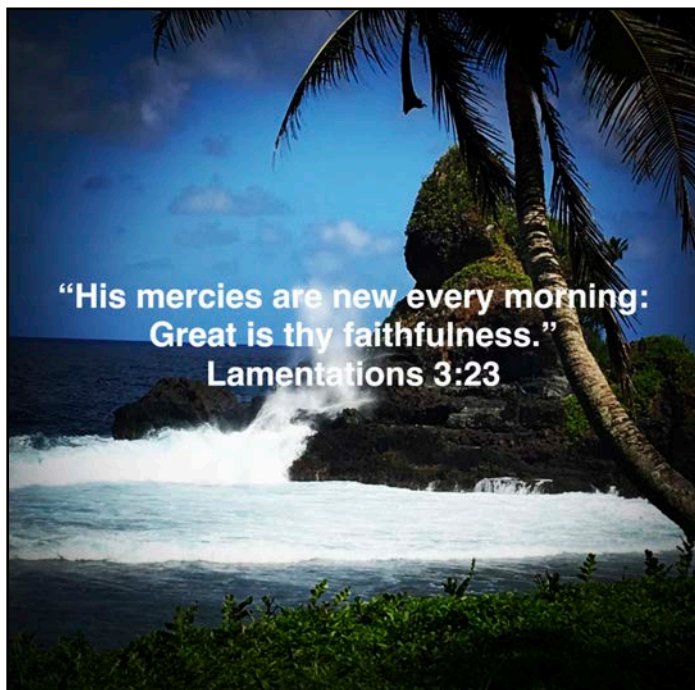

 His last words to us. Our scriptural mandate.

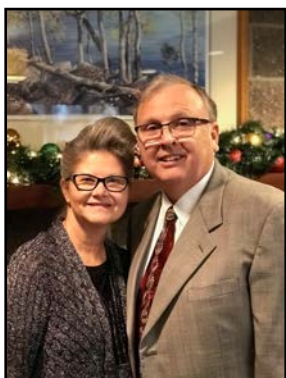


There are presently 17 Bible Schools in operation in the Region.

We are thankful to God for providing the necessary finances which afforded us the privilege to visit 14 Pacific nations during 2017, most of which were National Conferences and Board Meetings. (Philippines, Solomon Islands, Tonga, Samoa, American Samoa, Guam, Malaysia, New Zealand, New Caledonia, Vanuatu, Timor-Leste, Singapore, Papua New Guinea, Fiji) We are grateful for His traveling mercies.

Allow me this opportunity to express our sincere appreciation to each and every one for your kindness, respect, and genuine hospitality extended to us as we visit your nations. It is our joy to be with each of you in your respective nations. We are refreshed by your fellowship, your worship, and your passion to reach your cities, villages, ethnic groups, and outer islands!

We rejoice in the many victories of 2017! Throughout our Pacific islands last year, we give God praise for 11,778 baptisms in the Name of Jesus, 11,390 receiving the gift of the Holy Spirit, 114 new churches opened, 220 newly licensed ministers, and an increase of 264 Bible School students!

In reflection, while rejoicing for the above victories, we also

understand that 2017 was an extremely difficult year for many. Some nations have faced, and are yet facing, great challenges.

The Pacific Region lost several great heroes of the faith, with several nations suffering more than one loss. We grieve with you, but may the lives lived by these great men serve as a reminder to all of us now in leadership roles -

In order to leave something meaningful behind, we must be intentional in creating something valuable in the days and years ahead.

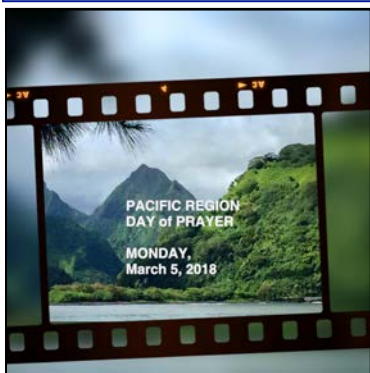
Strengthening and supporting our **REGIONAL MISSIONS Program** is imperative if we are to reach our UNREACHED nations!
