





The Resilience of the PACIFIC Region

Category 5 CYCLONE HAROLD caused widespread destruction and grief in the **Solomon Islands, Vanuatu, Fiji and Tonga** during April 2020.



Packing winds as high as 270 km/h (165mph), Cyclone Harold, the most powerful storm yet of 2020, resulted in 30 deaths, heavy flooding, destruction of crops and loss of property of \$123.5 million USD.
